Sealed bids for the construction of CC2021-05-Pensacola Beach Wastewater Treatment Plant Manhole Replacement & CIPP Lining will be received in the office of the Purchasing and Stores Manager, Emerald Coast Utilities Authority, located in the Emergency Operations & Support Addition, 9255 Sturdevant Street, Ellyson Industrial Park, Pensacola, Florida 32514, until 2:00 p.m., local time, Thursday, December 3, 2020 at which time bids submitted will be publicly opened and read aloud in the adjacent Room 2202, Finance Conference Room. Bids received after 2:00 p.m., local time, Thursday, December 3, 2020, will be returned unopened. A MANDATORY pre-bid conference will be held at the Pensacola Beach WWTP, 53 Via DeLuna, Pensacola Beach, Florida, 32562, at 10:00 a.m., local time, on Friday, November 20, 2020. Following this meeting, all entities desiring to be eligible to submit a proposal shall accompany the Engineer and Owner to the project site. This will fulfill the pre-bid site visit requirement. Be sure to have your Site Visit Verification Form signed by an ECUA representative (See page 16 of the Contractor's Proposal). Bids submitted on behalf of an entity that did not complete a site visit will not be considered. The principle features of the work will consist of the replacement of an existing 4-foot diameter precast concrete manhole with a new polymer concrete manhole, lining of an existing 4-foot diameter brick and an existing 4-foot diameter precast manhole, and CIPP lining of 309 LF of 18-inch CI sanitary sewer line.

Oral and other interpretations or clarifications will be without legal effect.
