



ECUA GENERAL RESOLUTION NO. GR20-19

A GENERAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF BID AND AWARDING CONTRACT; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH CORE & MAIN FOR THE PURCHASE OF NEW FIRE HYDRANTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$172,152.34, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THE CONTRACT.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EMERALD COAST UTILITIES AUTHORITY:

WHEREAS, on July 21, 2020, the Emerald Coast Utilities Authority (hereinafter "ECUA") received competitive bids for a contract, Bid Number 2020-09, to provide new fire hydrants and associated parts at fixed prices as needed to stock ECUA's warehouse; and

WHEREAS, the bids received from the contractors are shown in the table below; and

Vendor	Bid Amount
Core & Main	\$172,152.34
Consolidated Pipe & Supply Company, Inc.	\$176,450.00
Ferguson Waterworks	\$182,990.00

WHEREAS, Core & Main was the lowest responsive bidder for the contract; and

WHEREAS, the M & H fire hydrants to be provided by Core & Main meet all of the specifications in the request for bids; and

WHEREAS, there are operating funds budgeted and available to purchase fire hydrants as needed; and

WHEREAS, the current Contract expired on August 31, 2020;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Emerald Coast Utilities Authority:

SECTION 1. ECUA hereby authorizes the acceptance of the bid and award of contract to Core & Main; and

SECTION 2. ECUA hereby directs and authorizes the Executive Director to execute the contract; and

SECTION 3. This resolution shall take effect upon adoption.



Originating Department: Regional Services


