

ECUA GENERAL RESOLUTION NO. GR20-29

A GENERAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF THE ANNUAL CONTRACT FOR UTILITY CONSTRUCTION WITH PENSACOLA CONCRETE CONSTRUCTION CO., INC.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EMERALD COAST UTILITIES AUTHORITY:

- WHEREAS, on November 29, 2018, the Emerald Coast Utilities Authority (hereinafter "ECUA") entered into an annual contract for Utility Construction (the "Contract") with Pensacola Concrete Construction Co., Inc.; and
- WHEREAS, the Contract allowed for three one-year options to extend; with pricing to remain the same as the original contract; and
- WHEREAS, the first extension of the contract was brought to the Citizens' Advisory Committee and approved on October 15, 2019; and
- WHEREAS, was brought to the ECUA Board and approved on October 22, 2019; and
- WHEREAS, on November 29, 2020, the first extension of the contract is set to expire; and
- WHEREAS, on August 27, 2020, Pensacola Concrete Construction Co., Inc., agreed to a second extension of the contract with no change in pricing.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Emerald Coast Utilities Authority:

SECTION 1. ECUA Board hereby directs and authorizes the Executive Director to extend the contract for the second of three annual extensions, which will expire on November 29, 2021, without further action; and
