

ECUA GENERAL RESOLUTION NO. GR20-51

A GENERAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF BID AND AWARDING OF A CONTRACT; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH CLEARCREEK COATINGS, LTD OF NEW CARLISLE, OHIO (CLEARCREEK) FOR \$825,150 TO PERFORM TANK MAINTENANCE AT SEVERAL SITES; AUTHORIZING THE USE OF FUNDS FROM RW817 - ELEVATED TANK MAINTENANCE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EMERALD COAST UTILITIES AUTHORITY:

- WHEREAS, the Emerald Coast Utilities Authority (hereinafter "ECUA") Board previously approved establishment of a Capital Improvement Program (CIP) project for maintenance of tanks across ECUA's potable water system; and
- WHEREAS, the ECUA hired an engineering firm, Tank Industry Consultants (TIC), to evaluate the tanks and prepare a bid package for the work; and
- WHEREAS, on September 22, 2020, ECUA received competitive bids for CC2020-12 Elevated Tank Maintenance 2020; and
- WHEREAS, the project was bid with a Base Bid and an Additive Alternate Bid; and
- WHEREAS, Clearcreek submitted the lowest responsive Base Bid and Additive Alternate bid for the project in the total amount of \$825,150; and
- WHEREAS, the staff requests a contingency amount of \$41,258 (5% of the total bid) for a total of \$866,408 (\$825,150 + \$41,258)


NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Emerald Coast Utilities Authority:

- SECTION 1. ECUA hereby authorizes the acceptance of the Base Bid plus the Additive Alternate Bid Item and award of contract to Clearcreek; and
- SECTION 2. ECUA hereby directs and authorizes the Executive Director to execute a contract consistent with the bid terms; and
- SECTION 3. ECUA hereby authorizes creation of a new project and the use of funds from the new project, with \$866,408 transferred from RW817 - Elevated Tank Maintenance; and

SECTION 4. This General Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.

EXPLANATION TO ECUA BOARD

Originating Department: Water Production

REMARKS:

Comprehensive tank evaluations are required every five years by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP). Tank evaluations were performed in 2018 and 2019 for several of ECUA's water storage tanks. These evaluations identified Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and safety work that needs to be done on one elevated storage tank and four ground storage tanks.

In addition, the evaluations indicated that the one elevated storage tank, the East Tank, is in need of a full coating replacement. This work will include removal of the existing coating and any corrosion through sandblasting, then re-application of the coating along with associated work.

This project was bid with an alternate which consisted of a fluoropolymer exterior coating system which retains its color (appearance) much longer than the base bid exterior coating system. The bids came in lower than the engineer's estimate of approximately \$1 million. (A copy of the proposed tank graphic is attached.)




