

ECUA GENERAL RESOLUTION NO. GR20-52

A GENERAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF AN AUTOCAR CHASSIS WITH 40-CUBIC-YARD MCNEILIUS ATLANTIC FRONT LOADER BODY FOR THE COMMERCIAL DIVISION OF THE SANITATION DEPARTMENT.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EMERALD COAST UTILITIES AUTHORITY:

- WHEREAS, the commercial division of the Emerald Coast Utilities Authority (hereinafter "ECUA") Sanitation Department utilizes front loading trucks to service commercial accounts using front-end loading dumpsters on both Pensacola Beach and the mainland of Escambia County; and
- WHEREAS, the Commercial Division uses two front-end loading trucks daily to service both garbage and recycling accounts; and
- WHEREAS, the ECUA's fleet of commercial front loading trucks consists of one 2015 model and two 2012 models, which are due for replacement; and
- WHEREAS, the damage to the Three Mile Bridge is causing the existing fleet of front loading trucks to travel longer distances to service Pensacola Beach and the fact that additional mileage is causing additional breakdowns and repairs, staff began looking for a front loading collection truck which is already built and available for purchase; and
- WHEREAS, the Action Truck Center, Inc., of Dothan, Alabama, provided a quote for this truck in the amount of \$290,018 with funding available in the Sanitation Department Capital Improvement Program (CIP) budget for project RT803; and
- WHEREAS, the Action Truck Center, Inc., will supply this equipment and pricing in accordance with the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Agreement, which was competitively solicited; and
- WHEREAS, the quote meets ECUA purchasing requirements under Section 13-3(h) of the ECUA Code.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Emerald Coast Utilities Authority:


- SECTION 1. ECUA hereby directs and authorizes the Executive Director to approve the purchase of the Autocar chassis with 40-cubic-yard McNeilus front load body from the

vendor, Action Truck Center, Inc., in accordance with Section 13-3(h) of the ECUA Code, in the amount of \$290,018 with funding from project RT803; and

EXPLANATION TO ECUA BOARD

Originating Department: Sanitation Department

PURPOSE: The Commercial Division of the Sanitation Department operates two front-end loading collection trucks to service commercial accounts on both Pensacola Beach and the Escambia County mainland daily. The ECUA's fleet consists of three front-end loading collection trucks, one 2015 model, and two 2012 models. The 2012 models are at the end of their useful life and one is scheduled to be replaced in FY 2021 as part of the normal vehicle replacement process.

Normally, staff would obtain bids for a compressed natural gas (CNG) front loader, and order it, and wait the typical nine months for manufacture and delivery of the truck. However, because of the damage to the Three Mile Bridge and the additional mileage these older trucks are being driven to service Pensacola Beach, staff began looking for front-end loading trucks which are already built and ready for delivery. Action Truck Center, Inc., informed staff they have a diesel front loader which meets all other normal ECUA specifications in stock and available for delivery in October 2020.


REMARKS: Action Truck Center, Inc., can provide the vehicle based on the competitively bid Sourcewell Purchasing Contract number 081716-ATC. The quote submitted by Action Truck Center, Inc., meets ECUA purchasing requirements. We respectfully request your approval to purchase the Autocar chassis with 40-cubic-yard McNeilus front load body in the amount of \$290,018. Funds are available in Sanitation Department CIP Project RT803 – Commercial Vehicle Replacement.


